ACTIVITY CONDUCT AGREEMENT

Student participants in all Chattanooga State sponsored events, activities, and conferences are subject at all times to the policies of the College and, in particular, the Student Handbook and the Student Disciplinary Policies regardless if the institution-sponsored activity is held on or off campus. A complete version of these and all campus policies can be found, in their entirety, in the Student Handbook located on the college website.

In addition, students participating in all Chattanooga State sponsored events, activities, and conferences acknowledge that they are aware of and will comply with the following College policies:

DRUG-FREE CAMPUS POLICY

It is the policy of Chattanooga State Community College that the unlawful manufacture, distribution, possession, or use of alcohol and/or illicit drugs on the Chattanooga State campus, or any property owned or controlled by Chattanooga State, or as part of any activity of Chattanooga State, is strictly prohibited. All employees and students are subject to applicable federal, state, and local laws related to this matter. Any violation of this policy will result in disciplinary sanctions.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR OTHER CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES VIOLATIONS

The use and possession of alcoholic beverages and controlled substances are governed by the various federal and state laws and the college's Alcohol and Drug Policy found in the Policies and Procedures section of the Student Handbook which is available at the Office of the Vice President for Student Affairs, the Dean of Student Life, and on the college website. Violation of the law or the policy is prohibited. Such violations include, but are not limited to, the unauthorized or illegal consumption, distribution, manufacture, possession, or sale of alcoholic beverages or other controlled substances on campus grounds or within the college administrative, instructional and research facilities. This policy applies to ALL students including those of legal age for alcohol consumption. All college sanctioned events, activities and conferences are alcohol-free according to the college policy previously mentioned.

IMPROPER USE OR POSSESSION OF WEAPONS AND DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES

Use or possession of firearms, archery equipment, ammunition, explosives, incendiary devices, or other dangerous weapons, substances, or materials is prohibited except as expressly authorized by the College. NOTICE: Signs placed on Chattanooga State grounds attempt to notify entrants that weapons are prohibited. No person is permitted to carry a weapon on campus property or to school functions even if the possessor has a legal handgun permit. State of Tennessee Statute TCA 39-17-1359 allows a state or federal government entity or agent thereof to prohibit possession of weapons by any person at meetings conducted by, or on the premises owned, operated, managed, or under control of such government entity.
