COVID-19 Confirmed Positive Case



The identity of the individual must be kept confidential to the greatest extent possible.

If you have tested positive for COVID-19:

STUDENTS

You must immediately:

- 1. Leave campus.
- 2. Stay isolated for at least 5 days, and until you no longer have symptoms and have been fever free for 24 hours.*
- 3. Following the initial isolation, you should then properly wear a well-fitting face mask when you are around other people for an additional 5 days.
- 4. Notify your instructor(s) of your required isolation.

FACULTY & STAFF

You must immediately:

- 1. Leave campus.
- 2. Stay isolated for at least 5 days, and until you no longer have symptoms and have been fever free for 24 hours.*
- 3. Following the initial isolation, you should then properly wear a well-fitting face mask when you are around other people for an additional 5 days.
- Notify your immediate supervisor of your required isolation.

VISITORS

You must immediately:

- 1. Leave campus.
- 2. Stay isolated for at least 5 days, and until you no longer have symptoms and have been fever free for 24 hours.*
- Following the initial isolation, you should then properly wear a well-fitting face mask when you are around other people for an additional 5 days.

EWD STUDENTS/ CONTRACT INSTRUCTORS

You must immediately:

- 1. Leave campus.
- 2. Stay isolated for at least 5 days, and until you no longer have symptoms and have been fever free for 24 hours.*
- 3. Following the initial isolation, you should then properly wear a well-fitting face mask when you are around other people for an additional 5 days.
- 4. If an EWD student, notify your instructor or supervisor of your required isolation.

ISOLATING ON CAMPUS

Should you become ill or receive confirmation of a positive COVID-19 diagnosis and are unable to immediately leave campus, TCAT building 1, room 31 has been designated as the COVID-19 isolation area for TCAT students and employees. Room C56 in the CAT building has been designated as the COVID-19 isolation area for all non-TCAT students and employees.

COVID POSITIVE WITH SYMPTOMS

You can be around others after:

- 5 days since symptoms first appeared and
- 24 hours with no fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and
- Other symptoms of COVID-19 are improving*
- *Loss of taste and smell may persist for weeks or months after recovery and need not delay the end of isolation.

 Note that these recommendations do not apply to people with severe COVID-19 or with weakened immune systems (immunocompromised).

COVID POSITIVE WITHOUT SYMPTOMS

If you continue to have no symptoms, you can be with others after 10 days have passed since you had a viral test for COVID-19. If you develop symptoms after testing positive, follow the guidance above for "I think or know I had COVID-19, and I had symptoms."
