Students who receive a minimum score on the respective end of course assessment(s) can receive dual credit at Chattanooga State Community College in the respective courses, in accordance with Tennessee Board of Regents (TBR) Policy 2:01:00:05, Early Postsecondary Opportunities.

Upon conferment of a high school diploma from a Sequatchie County Schools , the student will notify the Sequatchie County Schools of his/her intent to attend Chattanooga State Community College . The Chattanooga State Community College will verify test scores and submit application for processing. For those students who meet all articulation requirements:

- 1. The student must be admitted to the College through the normal admissions and registration processes.
- 2. The Sequatchie County Schools will be responsible for ensuring all student documentation is forwarded to Chattanooga State Community College admissions office for credit awarding.
- 3. The Chattanooga State Community College faculty will be responsible for creating, administering, and assessing the dual credit end of course assessment.

Course credit will be awarded upon being officially admitted and enrolled at Chattanooga State Community College. The college course, credit hours and a grade of "Pass" will be shown on the Chattanooga State Community College transcript. Transfer of this dual credit to other institutions is at the discretion of the receiving institution.

Both the Sequatchie County Schools and Chattanooga State Community College shall comply with all applicable State and Federal laws and regulations, including without limitation the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and College policies and guidelines in the performance of this Agreement.

This Agreement shall be effective for the period commencing on August 1, 2024 and ending on June 30, 2025

This Agreement may be terminated by either party by giving written notice to the other at least thirty (30) days before effective date of termination.
