****Proof of Citizenship:** Proof of citizenship/lawful presence is required for all applicants. Please include a legible copy of your driver license with your admission application or email a copy to esc@chattanoogastate.edu. (If you have an out-of-state driver license or state issued ID, you must also submit a certified copy of your birth certificate or a valid U.S. passport.)

*****Additional Requirements:** Additional requirements may be added based on the information provided on your application or previous academic history.
