#### **SCHOOL & COMMUNITY**

Hamilton County's Collegiate High at Chattanooga State is a collaboration between Chattanooga State Community College and Hamilton County Schools.

The school, which opened its doors in the Fall Semester of 2001, is located on the campus of Chattanooga State Community College. Presently, Collegiate High students reflect the diversity of race, gender, socioe conomic levels, and exceptional education found throughout Hamilton County and North Georgia and enter Collegiate High from a variety of educational backgrounds including public, private, religious and home schools. Students have access to specialized support-mentoring, tutoring, counseling, peer encouragement, as well as an abundant amount of state-of-the-art learning technology. The Hamilton County Board of Education provides a program coordinator, a school counselor, a college advisor, a Math instructor and an English instructor. Chattanooga State offers college instruction, counseling, professional tutoring, mentoring services, classrooms, labs, technology, office and clerical support.

Students earn high school and college credit simultaneously. Collegiate High is, therefore, a school of opportunity for motivated students who possess academic potential and are looking for an educational experience beyond the traditional high school setting. It serves as a launch pad to further a student's academic endeavors and often allows them to graduate early and begin their college career ahead of their peers.

Collegiate High earned the National Blue Ribbon School distinction in 2020 and is recognized as a Level 5 Tennessee Reward School.
