## **MRIT 2300 Clinical Information**

Our MRI screening form is designed to protect people working in the MRI department where the magnetic field could cause harm to students with unsafe physical conditions, such as surgically implanted or attached medical devices. You will need to have your screening form reviewed by the MRI coordinator before you can be admitted to the clinic course.

Clinical experience includes a minimum of 180 hours of training per semester and competency evaluation of a variety of exams required to sit for the ARRT MRI registry. Being able to attend 2 days a week M-F is preferred, and clinic placement will go to the students who can meet this requirement.

## Students enrolling in the clinical course will be required to submit the following documentation to at their own cost:

- 1. 10-panel drug screen
- 2. criminal background check
- 3. physical exam
- 4. online record documentation fee
- 5. liability insurance (Chattanooga State Bursar's Office)
- 6. N95 respirator fit test
- 7. TB skin test
- 8. CPR (American Heart Association BLS for Healthcare Provider)
- 9. Immunizations or titers (hepatitis B, MMR, Tdap, varicella, seasonal flu)

These will be archived in My Record Tracker, which is a portable electronic self-charting system available to all Tennessee community college students for \$50.

Trajecsys online clinical tracking software must be purchased to record clinic attendance and daily exams. Cost is \$75.

Students affiliated with clinical sites in Tennessee are required to complete a series of general clinical orientation quizzes. All accepted students will be provided instructions for programmatic requirements prior to program start date.

Students enrolling in the MRIT 2300 MRI Clinical course will be required to attend a **mandatory** orientation session on the main campus prior to the beginning of scheduled clinical education assignment. Orientation information will be detailed once you are admitted to the program. Exceptions can be made in extreme circumstances.

Clinic uniforms are not required, but solid color scrubs are mandatory. No cartoon characters or prints maybe worn to clinic sites while you are representing Chattanooga State.
